Recent incidents

- Burglary to a barn on **Hever Lane, in Hever**. It took place between Monday 14th June at midday, and Friday 18th June at 4pm. Entry was gained by forcing the door. A red and black Rally Rotavator, a battery charger, a step ladder, and a Stihl chainsaw were stolen. Crime Reference BY 8745/10.
- Burglary to an outbuilding at a property in **Bitchet Green, near Seal**. It took place between Saturday 19th June at 5pm, and Sunday 20th June at 10:30am. Entry was gained by forcing the lock. A grey Mountfield ride-on lawnmower, a yellow Suzuki quad bike, 2 crash helmets, 2 bolt croppers, and some power tools were stolen. Crime Reference BY 8821/10.
- Theft from a property on **Spode Lane, in Cowden**. It took place at around 11:30am on Wednesday 23rd June. An orange and white Stihl hedge trimmer was stolen from a front garden, when left unattended briefly. Crime Reference BY 8986/10.
- Theft from a motor vehicle from a farm on **Hartley Bottom Road, in Hartley**. It took place between Thursday 24th June at 2pm, and Friday 25th June at 2pm. 15 Bales of hay were stolen from next to a tractor, and the tractor broken into and personal documents stolen. Crime Reference BY 9090/10.
- Burglary to a shed on **Nightingale Lane, in Ide Hill**. It took place between Thursday 24th June at 6pm, and Friday 25th June at 5:30am. Various power tools and a generator were stolen. Crime Reference BY 9072/10.
