Recent incidents

- Theft from an outbuilding at a **farm, Hale Oak Road** in Chiddingstone between Saturday 15th May and Friday 21st May. A Countax ride-on lawnmower and a Karcher pressure washer were stolen. Crime Reference BY 7295/10.
- Theft from a **farm near Hodsell Street**, at 5:10am on Wednesday 26th May. A 10 foot length of stainless steel piping was stolen from the grounds of a commercial unit at the farm. CCTV footage being examined shows a white van and three males climbing on to the site. Crime Reference BY 7516/10.
- Burglary at two houses in **Penshurst**, between 8am and 4:45pm on Monday 17th May. At one property, it is unknown how entry was gained, a laptop and a men's Ellesse watch were stolen. At the other property, a ladder was used to gain access to an insecure upstairs window, jewellery was stolen. Crime References BY 7070/10 and BY 7074/10.
- Burglary to an outbuilding on **Farningham Hill Road, in Farningham** between Monday 17th May at 5pm, and Tuesday 18th May at 7:30am. A strimmer and three motorised bikes were stolen. The bikes were as follows; 1) Childs mini moto motorbike 2) Blue quad bike 3) yellow child's quad bike. Crime Reference BY 7118/10.

There have recently been reports across England and Scotland of large amounts of livestock being stolen. Please remember to report any suspicious activity / people / vehicles to us, using the methods shown on the next page.

Information from Surrey Police –

- Between 22nd May and 26th May, items of tack were stolen from an outbuilding in Lingfield, Surrey.
- On 22nd May, A barn was broken into and a large number of tools and 2 motocross bikes were stolen, in the Oxted area.
